name	variety	type	h/h	days	description
Brussels Sprouts	Red Rubine		heir	90-100	Beautifully colored ruby red, almost purple sprouts. Grows to 24", may need staking in exposed areas.
Cauliflower	Fioretto 60		hyb	60	Unique, small heads in clusters, unlike the typical clubby types. Eat fresh, roasted, grilled, or stir fry. Second, lesser crop usually follows the first, on side shoots
Cucumber	Mini Munch	mini	hyb	50-60	Ideal snacking cuke, best when 3-4" long. Thin skin, no peeling necessary. High yield---all female flowers. Mild cuke flavor.
Cucumber	Armenian	novelty	heir	70	Tastes like a cuke, but is really in the melon family! Burpless, bitter free, with mild flavor. Beautifully striped and ribbed, up to 24" long. No peeling required. Best grown on a trellis.
Cucumber	Eureka Hybrid	mini	hyb	57	Can be picked tiny, for pickling, or up to 5". Superb disease resistance. Best grown on a trellis.
Cucumber	Green Fingers	mini	hyb	60	Mini cuke with thin skin. 4-4½" long, firm and crisp, tender and non bitter. Compact plant habit, ideal for containers or small gardens.
Cucumber	Lemon	novelty	heir	65	Round, yellow skinned cuke, about tennis ball size. Dates back to 1894. Called "lemon" because of color and shape, not flavor. Skins are thin, often eaten unpeeled. Excellent for salad or pickling. Plant grows to 24" high, with a semi-bush habit.
Eggplant	Meatball Hybrid	large	hyb	55-60	Large, vaguely bell shaped eggplant is denser than most. Very flavorful.
GREENS	Seven Top	turnip	heir	40-45	Grown for greens only, harvest when 12" long. Dark green, with serrated edge. Vitamin rich.
GREENS	Green Wave	mustard	heir	40-60	Dark green, deeply frilled and curled, 24" tall. Spicy hot flavor. Use as baby leaf or full grown. Bolt resistant.
Lettuce	Bronze beauty	leaf, oak	heir	40-50	Colorful, delicious, large dark leaves with ruffled edge. Hardy, bolt resistant. Green, arrow shaped leaves with bronze tips. Sweet, crisp flavor.
Okra	Bowling Red		heir	57	Huge plants, up to 7' tall. Fruit is dark red, about 6" long, and many are curved. Attractive foliage and flowers.

Okra	Candle Fire		hyb	60	Smooth, ribless pods colored rosy red, about 4" long. Pick continuously all summer. Great flowers too.
Oregano	Cleopatra		heir	80-90	Award winner, mildly spicy, peppermint flavor (some say). Compact, creeping habit. Silver Gray leaves. Well drained soil yields best results.
Pepper	Aji Rico	hot	heir	55, 75	Mildly hot small pepper with a hint of citrus. Bright red when fully ripe. Pepper size 2-4". Compact plant habit---- ideal for pots. Under 500 Scoville units.
Pepper	Alma Paprika	hot	heir	80	Paprika pepper, 1-2" size, oblate, roundish fruit starts out creamy white, then orange, and finally red. Beautiful at any stage. For drying, allow peppers to turn red. Can be eaten at any stage. Mild heat. Scoville units 1,000-2,000.
Pepper	Buena Mulata	hot	heir		6-7" long, thin pepper. Color is lavender to purple, turning dark red when fully ripe. Fruit is hottest when purple; a little sweeter when fully ripe. Highly ornamental. 10,000-20,000 Scoville units.
Pepper	Chiltepin (Birdseye)	hot	heir	90	Native to North America. The pepper resembles a pea---a tiny, round or oval-shaped, red to orange/red chili, quite hot. The attractive red peppers are held atop the foliage. 50,000-100,000 Scoville units.
Pepper	Purple Jalapeno	hot	heir	75-85	Striking pepper starts out green, turns purple, then red when fully ripe. Can be eaten when purple or red. Almost 3" long average. Scoville rating: 2,000-5,000.
Pepper	Scotch Bonnet	hot	heir	100	Habanero-like, very hot. Curiously twisted fruit is not as long as a habanero. Green, maturing to red. Sweet, smoky flavor is great for chili and hot sauces. 100,000-350,000 Scoville units.
Pepper	Big Daddy Hybrid	sweet	hyb	73	Huge Marconi (bullhorn) type, reaching 10". Turns glossy golden yellow when fully ripe. Thick walled with superb flavor.
Pepper	Candy Cane Red Hybrid	sweet	hyb	50-60	Beautiful, striped pepper; the striping diminishes as the fruit ripens. Pepper size about 3½" x 1½". Variegated leaves. Compact plant habit.
Pepper	Good as Gold Hybrid	sweet	hyb	72	7" tapered Italian pepper. Brilliant orange color when ripe. Excellent flavor.
Pepper	Tolli's Sweet Italian	sweet	heir	80	5" tapered sweet pepper. Bright red when fully ripe. Heavy yield. Good fresh, fried, dried, roasted or canned.

Pepper	Greek Pepperoncini	savory	heir	65	Considered to be sweet, but there is some heat so we classify it as a savory type. Small, turning yellowish green when fully ripe. Prolific. Usually used for pickling. Harvest when peppers are light yellow and 2-3" long. 100-500 Scoville units.
Pepper	Habanada	savory	hyb	70	Heatless habanero. Habanero flavor, but no heat. Beautiful orange color when ripe. Size about 2-3" long. Prolific.
Pepper	Hot Sunset Hybrid	savory	hyb	85	Banana type, with low heat---only 600 Scoville units. 7" long, tapered. Yellow, turning orange/red. Harvest anytime. Thick walls. Vigorous, with heavy yield.
Pepper	Mad Hatter	savory	heir	65	Small, unusually shaped, three sided pepper from Bolivia and Peru. 2-3½" long and 2-2½" wide. Sweet taste. Excellent fresh, pickled, or stuffed. Scoville rating about 500.
Pepper	Mexibell Hybrid	savory	hyb	70	Bell pepper with three or four lobes, 4-5" long. Mild chili flavor. Red when fully ripe. Award winner. 100-1,000 Scoville units.
Pepper	Sugar Rush Peach	savory	HH	75	Thin, long pepper is often interestingly contorted. Color is yellow to peach to golden orange. Flavor is described as tropical, and smoky. The plant can grow very tall for a pepper, sometimes 60"! Staking suggested. Heat is likened to a mild habanero, about 200,000 Scoville units.
Squash	Green Eggs Hybrid	summer Zuke	hyb	50-55	Zucchini type summer squash, despite its shape---5" long oval. Creamy flesh, nutty flavor. Dark green skin.
Squash	Rotem	summer	hyb	47	"Marrow" type summer squash. Smooth, pale green skin. Size about 6-8" long and up to 3" wide. Tender flesh with sweet buttery flavor. Compact habit. Prolific.
Squash	Autumn's Choice	winter	hyb	85-90	Beautifully colored butternut type squash. Fruits average 10" long. Deep orange flesh is rich and sweet. Vine length about 12'. Mildew resistant.
Tomato	Atlas	standard	hyb	65-75	l, 14-20 oz red beefsteak. Compact habit (semi-determinate), ideal for pots. Old time tomato flavor.
Tomato	Big Daddy Hybrid	standard	hyb	72	l, 15 oz average. This is an improved version of the famous 'Burpee Big Boy.' It has the same flavor, with improved disease resistance and higher yield.
Tomato	BHN 589 Hybrid	standard	hyb	75	D, A new, highly disease resistant variety. Crack resistant. True tomato taste. Avg 8-12 oz.

Tomato	Bobcat	standard	hyb	68	D, 10 oz fruit, classic shape. Disease resistant, prolific, tasty beefsteak type.
Tomato	Damsel	standard	heir	75	I, 8-12 oz, large oblate pink/red fruit, heirloom flavor, disease resistant.
Tomato	Fireworks	standard	heir	60	I, 6-8 oz fruits----rather large, considering its earliness. Very tasty too, also uncommon in early varieties. Vigorous.
Tomato	Miracle Sweet Hybrid	standard	hyb	67	I, Reputedly the sweetest tomato there is, outside of cherry tomatoes. Red, average size is 5 oz. Disease resistant.
Tomato	Mrs. Maxwell's Big Italian Heirloom	standard	heir	70-80	I, One of the earliest beefsteaks, with reddish pink flesh. 1-2 lb average. Good fresh or canned. Has potato leaf.
Tomato	Original Blue Ribbon	standard	hyb	71	I, 11-13 oz average. Very disease resistant, productive, improved 'Goliath'.
Tomato	Pretty in Pink	standard	heir	73	I, Average 6-8 oz, mild flavor, disease resistant. From Asia.
Tomato	Red Brandywine	standard	HH	80	I, Modern hybrid with heirloom parents: (Brandywine x Amish) 10-14 oz red fruit, tastier than either parent, vigorous.
Tomato	Orange Slice Hybrid	standard, novelty	hyb	75	I, Orange beefsteak type, averaging 16 oz. Reputed to have richer flavor than other orange types. Prolific.
Tomato	Pineapple	standard, novelty	heir	90	I, Beautiful yellow, heavily streaked with red. 16 oz average. Meaty, beefsteak type, with fewer seeds and very solid. Old fashioned, full bodied flavor.
Tomato	Sunny Boy	standard, novelty	hyb	70	I, 8-12 oz bright yellow fruit, globe shaped, beefsteak type. Mild pleasant flavor.
Tomato	Tazmanian Chocolate	standard, novelty	HH	75	D, Newer hybrid of 'New Big Dwarf' and 'Paul Robeson.' The plant only grows to 2-3' tall. Fruit characteristics are like Robeson. Very flavorful.
Tomato	Thorburn's Terra-Cotta	standard, novelty	heir	75-85	I, Honey-brown skin, orange pink flesh, and a green seed mass----a most spectacularly colored tomato!
Tomato	True Black Brandywine	standard, novelty	heir	85	I, 6-14 oz fruit, large, globe to oblate shaped, shoulders that are a dusky, dark mahogany color. Potato leaf.
Tomato	Giant Oxheart	paste	heir	90	I, Meaty, heart shaped pink, size varies widely, up to 32 oz. Old variety with few seeds.
Tomato	LaRoma III	paste	hyb	76	D, Bright red, meaty fruits, 5-8 oz. Thick walls, full of flavor. Great for tomato puree, paste, and sauce. The flesh is meaty and not too wet, so it will cook down into a thick sauce. It freezes well too, for later cooking.

Tomato	Mama Leone Plum	paste	heir	75	I, Tapered plum tomato from Italy. 5-6 oz, meaty fruit with few seeds. Rated as one of the top ten for sauce.
Tomato	Plum Regal	paste	hyb	75	D, Deep red plum, meaty, crack resistant, 3-4 oz average. Resistant to late blight and somewhat to early blight.
Tomato	San Marzano Gigante	paste	heir	90	I, Jumbo strain of the old favorite paste tomato. Up to 7" long and 2½" wide. Red, sometimes with green streaks on shoulders. Robust flavor, dense flesh and few seeds.
Tomato	Cherry Buzz	small	hyb	55	I, Extra early red cherry. Small fruit---½" to ¾" diameter. Sweet, tasty, and productive. Crack resistant. Ferny foliage.
Tomato	Chocolate Pear	small	hyb	65-70	I, A pear shaped tomato, about the size of a cherry. Light red in color, overlaid with swirled hues of green or brown.
Tomato	Esterina	small	hyb	60	I, Slightly elongated yellow cherry fruit but not quite a grape. 1¼" diameter. Ultra sweet and tasty. Vigorous, prolific, disease resistant.
Tomato	Jasper	small	hyb	60	I, Sweet, crack resistant red cherry, about ¾" wide. Resistant to early and late blight.
Tomato	Montesino	small	hyb	60-65	I, Red grape. 1" wide and 1½" long. Very dense flesh so good for drying.
